

List of Kolhapur Shilahar kings

Jatiga I (940-960 CE)-Rashtrakuta feudatory, founder of the dynasty

Naivarman (960-980 CE)

Chandra (980-1000 CE)

Jatiga II (1000-1020 CE)- helped Tailapa-II to re-establish Chalukya rule,

Gonka (1020-1050 CE)-son of Jatiga-II

Guhala I (1050 CE)- son of Jatiga-II, close friend of Chalukya king Satyashrya

Marsimha (1050-1075 CE)- daughter Chandralekha married with Vikramaditya-VI (Chalukya king)

Guhala II (1075-1085 CE)- son of Marsimha

Bhoja-I (1085-1100 CE)- son of Marsimha

Ballala (1100-1108 CE)- son of Marsimha

Gonka II (1108 CE)- son of Marsimha

Gandaraditya I (1108-1138 CE)-most famous king of dynasty, construction of Kopeswar mandir started.

Vijayaditya-I (1138-1175CE)- helped Anantdev-I to regain northern Shilahar throne, helped Bijaala-II to defeat Tailapa-III leading to breakdown of Chalukya power.

Bhoja II (1175-1212 CE)- last ruler of dynasty, defeated by Singhan-II

Note: - The list contains the names of the reigning king, the rest of the sons/daughters/relatives are not considered here. The list was taken from the History of Shilahar dynasty & their epigraphs written by V V Mirashi (VSM, Nagpur, 1974)
